You can draw holiday-specific pictures, houses, landscapes, fun designs and abstracts, snowflakes, people, ski resorts, snowmen, turkeys, animals, food, or any positive or cute image you wish, and you can say anything you want that is encouraging or positive.

The most popular placemats have one-liner corny jokes (like: "What did the bunny say to the carrot? It has been nice gnawing you.") or humorous stories & comments.
